#### **TEST UPDATE**

Effective immediately, Pacific Diagnostic Laboratories (PDL) is sending **Thyroid Stimulating Immunoglobulin (TSI)** test requests to our referral lab Lab Corp. This change is due to vendor supply issues that they are unable to resolve.

A new test code has been created for the LabCorp test:

The existing test code will be deactivated once outstanding orders have been addressed:

DEACTIVE: LAB746 THYROID STIMULATING IMMUNOGLOBULIN

For specimens already submitted for this testing, PDL will cancel and reorder under the new code. Testing will be submitted to LabCorp as soon as possible.

**Specimen Requirements** 

Specimen Type: Serum or plasma (EDTA or Lithium heparin)

Specimen Container: Red-top tube, gel-barrier tube, lavender-top (EDTA) tube or green-top (heparin) tube

<u>Collection</u>: Serum or plasma must be separated from blood cells by centrifugation, ideally within 2 hours of collection. If red-top tube or plasma, transfer separated serum or plasma to a plastic transport tube.

Specimen Volume: 3 mL (0.3 mL min volume)

**Transport Temperature:** Room Temperature
