Effective February 16, 2024, Pacific Diagnostic Laboratories (PDL) will be returning to regular testing for ALANINE AMINOTRANSFERASE (ALT / SGPT).

BACKGROUND

- Our test vendor experienced a nation-wide shortage of ALT test reagent.
- To manage the test reagent we had on hand, we had to ration ALT testing.
- We are pleased to report that we have enough reagent to resume normal testing for ALT.

IMPACTED TESTS

Beginning February 16, 2024, PDL will **RESUME** providing the ALT test result for the following orderable codes:

COMPREHENSIVE METABOLIC PANEL (CMP)
 EXPANDED COMPREHENSIVE METABOLIC PANEL LAB9403

Please note that there may be a short transition period for some test orders as we make the changes in our system.
