

# LithoLink (KIDNEY STONE) TEST UPDATE:

## **Collection Limitations for Litholink 24-hour Urine Panel**

August 19, 2024

Pacific Diagnostic Laboratories (PDL) has noted a number of recollections for kidney stone analysis, **Litholink 24-hour Urine Panel** (Kidney Stone) LAB11005 due to specimen stability limitations.

#### To avoid recollections:

- Collection must start on Sunday or Monday or Tuesday.
- Drop-off to the lab on a Monday or Tuesday or Wednesday.
