PDL UPDATE



Blood Bank Specimen Collection Requirements

June 28, 2022

Pacific Diagnostic Laboratories (PDL) is providing this update on the identification, collection and documentation requirements for BLOOD BANK/TRANSFUSION SPECIMENS as part of our Quality Assurance program.

Due to the *significant clinical risk* if a patient specimen is misidentified, PDL has strict criteria for acceptability of specimens for blood bank/transfusion specimens in alignment with federal regulations.

PLEASE NOTE

A recollection will be requested if the specimen is not labeled correctly, or the labeled specimen does not match the lab order/requisition.

- LAB895 ABO/RH BLOOD TYPE
- LAB276 TYPE AND SCREEN
- LAB274 DIRECT COOMBS (DAT)
- LAB9484 TYPE AND SCREEN (PRE-ADMIT)
- LAB9401 TYPE AND SCREEN, NO CROSSMATCH

LABELING AND ORDER REQUIREMENTS

To avoid delays in testing please be sure of the following:

- COLLECTOR/PHLEBOTOMIST INFORMATION is documented and traceable
 - → Collector information can be documented in an EMR system and/or
 - → Collector information can be documented on the specimen order/requisition
- SPECIMEN LABEL includes:
 - → Patient full name (first and last name)
 - → Date of birth (DOB)
 - → Date and time of specimen collection
- SPECIMEN ORDER/REQUISITION matches specimen label information:
 - → Patient demographics (patient full name, DOB)
 - → Collection information (date and time)

PLEASE NOTE:

PDL no longer requires the submission of the form "Off Site Collection of Blood Specimens for Crossmatch and/or Type & Screen (TYCS)" with these specimens.
