PDL does not offer any collection services for this testing at the Patient Services Centers. Nasal collections must be performed by: Physician or other healthcare provider If self-collection is done it must be under the observation of a healthcare professional and follow CDC guidelines PDL COVID Collection Sites are available by appointment only for symptomatic patients at Goleta and Santa Ynez.
